Camp Guidelines

EQUINE RELEASE OF LIABILITY

I, with the intention of binding myself, my spouse and heirs, legal representatives, and assigns, voluntarily and knowingly execute this Release of Liability in favor of Flying Eagle Ranch LLC, its agents, and employees.

I, acknowledge that riding horses entails known and unanticipated risks which could result in physical or emotional injury, paralysis, death, or damage to me, to property, or to third parties. I understand that such risks simply cannot be eliminated without jeopardizing the essential qualities of the activity. The risks include, among other things: A horse, regardless of its training and usual past behavior, may act unpredictably based upon instinct or fright which may cause me to be thrown from my horse or injured by the horse. Horses may do such things as bite, kick, buck, lie down, or stumble. Saddles may slip and other tack or saddle problems may develop as a result of normal use and wear. Flying Eagle Ranch, LLC may misjudge the risks of the horse I am assigned to ride, and my abilities. My horse may collide with obstacles or encounter variations in terrain such as woodlands, marsh, beach, ocean, bridges, well-traveled roads, wild animals, birds, debris, and other obstacles, whether obvious or not and whether man made or natural. Each of those obstacles or variations in terrain could cause me to lose control of my horse and I could fall. Riding a horse requires me to balance on the saddle. I could lose my balance which could result in falling from the horse. Furthermore, Flying Eagle Ranch, LLC trail guides and instructors have difficult jobs to perform. They seek safety, but they are not infallible. They may be ignorant of my fitness or abilities, or may misjudge the weather, the elements, or the terrain. They may give inadequate warnings or instructions, and the equipment being used might malfunction, even if it is in good condition.

I am hiring a horse to ride today and throughout my stay at camp at my own risk, which I voluntarily assume. In consideration of the fee charged and paid by me, I hereby release Flying Eagle Ranch LLC and its agents and employees and agree to hold it (them) harmless for any and all liabilities, claims, damages, actions and causes of action whatsoever, for loss, damage, or injury to person or property, irrespective of how arising, and however caused including but not limited to all kinds and degrees or extent of negligence (except willful or wanton negligence or misconduct), which Flying Eagle Ranch LLC or those others released hereby may commit or be charged with in connection, directly or indirectly with the riding or using of a horse (horses) or stables or any activity in connection herewith.
